Brief:

To install a new play park into this large open playing field, South East of Aylesbury including the demolition and removal of the existing play equipment.

The new play area is part of a 3 stage installation including ball court and teenage equipment. The first stage Playground is aimed at the 2-12 age group and in addition to the equipment required the installation of new access paths, bow top fencing, gates, earth mounding and Mattas safety surfacing. All disturbed areas were reinstated with turf to provide instant access to the play facility.
